

## **Junior Selection panel – key information**

### **Purpose of the Role**

- To select the team to compete at the Junior World Rowing Championships.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Identifying and selecting athletes to attend trials
- Recommendation of team coaches to RNZ
- Conducting trials – erg testing, on water seat trials, time trialing per RNZ selection policy
- Selecting the team to compete at Junior World Rowing Championships
- Post trial athlete meeting, for unsuccessful athletes
- Regular follow up with team coaches and crews progress

### **Core capabilities**

- Relationship management skills – strong interpersonal skills to develop and manage relationships
- Communication skills – excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Work Ethic – a self-starter who has a strong work ethic and the ability to work alone or within a team environment.
- Positive 'Can Do' attitude - be proactive and the ability to manage demanding situations with a positive disposition and a practical, strategic approach.
- Full New Zealand Drivers Licence
