

# ROWING NEW ZEALAND ("RNZ") 2023-2024 HIGH PERFORMANCE SELECTION GUIDELINES

RNZ intends to select crews for one or more of the following regattas, subject to meeting performance standards:

<u>In order to be considered this year for our Elite team and Olympic Nomination – athletes must already be part of the NZOC long list</u>

#### **ELITE SELECTION PROCESS**

a) ELITE SELECTION TRIAL 1

30 January – 3 February 2024, Lake Karāpiro

Lightweight Weight Requirement: Below 60kg Women Below 73kg Men

b) **ELITE SELECTION TRIAL 2** 

19 - 23 February 2024, Lake Karapiro

## 1. HOW TO QUALIFY FOR A SELECTION TRIAL

#### **SUMMER SQUAD ATHLETES**

- 1.1 All Athletes selected into the Summer Squad shall be eligible for an Elite Selection Trial 1 and/or 2 providing they meet the following conditions:
  - a) Have already been registered with NZOC for the Paris Olympics athlete long list;
  - b) Have completed a 5km and 2km erg test within the timeframes set out below, in the presence of an RNZ Coach

**2023** Ergometer 5km Test Completed before 11 December 2023

**2024** Ergometer 2km Test Completed between 22 – 28 January 2024

Lightweights Weight Requirement:

January 2k Below 61kg Women, 73kg Men

c) Participated in the In house time trialling before Christmas Regatta and North Island Club Championships

d) Participated in the Christmas Regatta and North Island Club Championships

Christmas Regatta, Lake Karapiro 15-17 December 2023 — Boats Premier 1x/2-North Island Club Champs, Lake Karāpiro 26 — 29 January 2024 — Boats Premier 1x/2-

- e) A trialist list for Elite Trial 1 will be announced before 29 January 2024 on the Rowing NZ Website. A trialist list for Elite Trial 2 will be announced on Sunday 18 February 2024 on the Rowing NZ website.
- f) Note: any exceptions to the requirements above i.e., cannot attend due to injury, bereavement, or the like need to be approved in advance by the RNZ General Manager Performance.

#### PERFORMANCE HUB/CLUB BASED ATHLETES

- 1.3 All Performance Hub and club based athletes that have been registered with NZOC on the Paris Olympics long list, and have completed the online nomination form shall be eligible for Elite Trial 1 or 2 providing they shall have:
  - a) Completed a 5km and 2km erg test within the timeframes set out below and submitted a photo of their erg screen to RNZ

**2023** Ergometer 5km Test Completed before 11 December 2023

**2024** Ergometer 2km Test Completed between 22 – 28 January 2024

b) Participated in the Christmas Regatta and the North Island Club Championships

Christmas Regatta, Lake Karapiro 15-17 December 2023 – Boats Premier 1x/2-North Island Club Champs, Lake Karāpiro 26 – 29 January 2024 – Boats Premier 1x/2-

c) Participated in the NZ Club Championships Regatta

New Zealand Club Champs, Lake Karāpiro 13 – 17 February 2024 – Boats Premier 1x/2-

- d) A trialist list for Elite Trial 1 will be announced before 29 January 2024 on the Rowing NZ Website. A trialist list for Elite Trial 2 will be announced on Sunday 18 February 2024 on the Rowing NZ website.
- e) Note: any exceptions to the requirements above i.e., cannot attend due to injury, bereavement, or the like need to be approved in advance by the RNZ General Manager Performance.

- 1. Nomination forms on Rowing NZ website/High Performance: Nomination Forms
- 2. All ergometer testing (with exception of Summer Squad) to be validated by sending in a photo of the erg test screen to RNZ either via the team specific nomination form or link on the <u>nomination page</u>.
- 3. Athletes may be required to contribute to the costs of the tours and to relocate to Karāpiro.
- 4. All athletes must hold a New Zealand Passport at the time of nomination.
