Services Required

Role and Responsibilities-

The Canterbury Rowing Association is seeking to contract a regional coach/coaches to facilitate the development of athletes over the winter period in 2019. The Regional coaches would be responsible for running a winter training program accessible to athletes from all Canterbury Clubs. The winter program would act as a wider training squad for the interprovincial team; this team and crews would be selected towards the end of the winter development program.

We are looking for multiple candidates who are based in different areas of the Canterbury Region to allow winter training throughout the region. The exact structure of the winter program will be based largely on where successful applicants are based.

The purpose of this role is to grow our representation at the Interprovincial Championships held in October, and to promote continued participation in rowing to those who are unable to participate in the Southern Rowing Performance Centre winter program.

A summary of core roles and responsibilities are as follows:

- Provide regular coaching for the winter training group.
- Assist the SRPC winter coaches with winter development camps held throughout the region.
- Co-ordinate with athletes a suitable training program that fits around school, university or work commitments.
- Assist the CRA selectors in selecting crews for the interprovincial regatta (October 2019).
- Recruit and support the retention of rowers from schools into winter system.
